

Buying Your Puppy

Forms of Payment- We only accept **CASH**, “US POSTAL” Money Orders, and Credit Cards through **PayPal**. We will no longer accept Personal Checks. We do not accept E-checks through PayPal except for deposits. If you are using PayPal, the buyer is responsible for the 3% fee charged by PayPal. Please increase the amount of money you are sending by 3% when processing the transaction. This fee is not refundable nor does it come off the final payment of the puppy.

Placing a Deposit- Puppies are not guaranteed to anyone until a deposit is **RECEIVED**. The deposit must be at least 50% of the listed price. In addition you must fax or email the “Puppy Deposit Form” detailing the specific puppy you are requesting to reserve in your name. Deposits are non-refundable after the puppy reaches 6 weeks of age. We will accept a “US POSTAL” Money Order for deposit if mailed with the Deposit Form; however, you must contact us via phone or email on the date the money order is mailed. The puppy will be placed on a temporary HOLD for a 3 day period while the money order is in transit. If the Money order is not received within the 3 day period, the puppy will be taken off HOLD and placed back up for adoption. It is best to have a tracking number on your mail or use overnight service. If mailing a Money Order, it must be received prior to delivery of the puppy.

Holding a Puppy- A puppy will not be held for anyone without a **FULL** deposit. Please do not ask us to HOLD a puppy without a deposit. We take many phone calls inquiring about puppies and the only way we KNOW you are serious about purchasing one is if we receive a deposit to place the puppy on HOLD in your name. Please keep in mind that the puppy you are looking at TODAY and considering placing a deposit on tomorrow is the SAME puppy that someone else might have looked at YESTERDAY and is placing a deposit on TODAY.

Shipping your Puppy- We will ship a puppy within the continental US for an additional \$275. This fee is to cover the shipping crate, health certificate and plane fare. Puppies are not shipped prior to 8 weeks of age. It is at the Breeder’s discretion to hold the puppy longer if the Breeder finds any health reasons preventing the puppy to fly at 8 weeks old (such as size-i.e. toy). If the purchaser wishes to have the puppy shipped and the Breeder deems it permissible, the final payment for the puppy and the shipping charges must be received no later than 1 week prior to the puppy’s departure.

Final Payment- Final payment may be provided thru **PayPal** if the buyer makes the payment 1 week prior to picking the puppy up or having the puppy shipped. Otherwise, the final payment **MUST be in CASH**. The puppy will not be allowed to leave the Breeder’s possession until final payment (**PAYMENT IN FULL**) is received. **ABSOLUTELY NO CHECKS WILL BE ACCEPTED.**

Local Pick-Up / Delivery- We frequently make trips to the Austin area and do not mind meeting a buyer to deliver a puppy. We will also meet a buyer within 200 miles of our home for an additional fee. Anyone who wishes to see our facility/home is welcome to pick the puppy up from us in person at our home address with a pre-arranged appointment.

Newborn Puppy Care- Our puppies have been raised in our home with daily love and attention. Each puppy is taken to the vet for an initial checkup within 3 days of birth. At that time the vet docks

their tails and dew claws. The puppies are given a dewormer at intervals recommended by our veterinarian. At three weeks old the puppies are introduced to a milk replacement formula to get them ready to wean from the mother. At four weeks the puppies are started on moistened puppy food until their teeth come in strong and then switched to a quality dry puppy food before they are six weeks old. At six weeks of age, the puppies are taken back to the vet for their first set of DHLPP shots. Puppies are not allowed to leave the Breeder's possession without these vet checks and shots; therefore, puppies are held until they reach 7 weeks of age.

Health Guarantee- As you can see it is our endeavor to raise healthy puppies and provide them with loving homes. As a result, we guarantee the health of each puppy sold. We require the new owner to have their new puppy examined by a vet within **72 hours** of taking possession of the animal. If the vet finds the puppy to be unsound, the new owner must return the puppy within 48 hours of the exam with a letter from the licensed vet stating the medical reason for returning the puppy. (Worms, hernias, and ear mites are typical in puppies; therefore, they will not be warranted by this policy.) We will return the purchase price of the puppy less any fees incurred due to the transaction; however, we will not reimburse for vet bills incurred. However, if the new owner authorizes their vet to proceed with any treatment without written authorization from the breeder, this policy is null and void.

In addition to the 3 day return policy, we offer a 1 year health guarantee against any **LIFE THREATENING GENETIC DEFECTS**. Should your new puppy be diagnosed by a licensed vet with a life threatening genetic defect during the first 12 months following your purchase, we will replace the puppy with another puppy of the same sex and value when available. The genetically defected puppy must be returned to the Breeder within 48 hours of the exam with a letter from the licensed veterinarian stating the life threatening ailment the animal is afflicted with. Once returned, we will have our vet perform an exam within 72 hours to confirm the original vet's diagnosis. Should our vet be unable to confirm the life threatening genetic defect, the Breeder will not be held accountable for the guarantee and an exchange will be at the Breeder's discretion. (Please Refer to the document named PURCHASE AGREEMENT for Full Disclosure of our Policy)

Limited Registration- Our puppies are sold with limited AKC registration unless otherwise requested. Limited registration means the animal will be a family pet only. Should the dog reproduce, the puppies will be ineligible for registration with the AKC. Due to the overpopulation of unwanted pets and irresponsible breeding, we required the new owner have the pet altered by 9 months of age. This is in the best interest of the pet as well as the owner because many pets become afflicted with ailments such as PYOMETRA because they have not been altered. This can be deadly as well as expensive to treat.

Full Registration- Should the new owner wish to use the animal as part of their breeding program, we will perform an extensive interview inquiring about breeding practices to ensure the puppy is going into a safe environment. We do not sell our puppies to pet stores, puppy mills, or irresponsible breeders. There is an additional fee assessed in addition to the listed price to obtain FULL breeding rights of any dog listed on our site.
